- 4. All speakers of presentations are obliged to disclosure conflicts of interest.
- 5. The types and registration methods of presentation data vary depending on the program. Detailed information will be posted on the website of the annual meeting and also sent to speakers via email.
- 6. First, use PowerPoint's built-in slide show recording feature, narrating over your slides as if presenting to an audience. Once the recording is complete, save the file using either the PowerPoint (.pptx) file format. Then, navigate to the 47<sup>th</sup> JSLTM Annual Meeting website and upload the file. Further guidance can be found on the conference website.
- 7. Your presentation data are temporarily stored in the PC preview center or the presentation server. We will responsibly destroy all data after the meeting.
